AND WHEREAS the Council consider that development of the said descriptions would be prejudicial to the proper planning of their area and would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area and that the provisions of paragraph 4 of Article 5 of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 apply.

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the power conferred on them by Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule below.

THIS DIRECTION is made under Article 4(1) of the said Order and in accordance with Article 5(4), shall remain in force until 12th February 2006 (being six months from the date of this Direction) and shall then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for Environment, Transport and the Regions:

Part 2: MINOR OPERATIONS

Class A. The erection, construction, maintenance, improvement or alteration of a gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure

being development comprised within Class A of Part 2, of Schedule 2 to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.

Part 4: TEMPORARY BUILDINGS AND USES

Class B. The use of any land for any purpose for not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year, of which not more than 14 days in total may be for the purposes referred to in paragraph B.2, and the provision on the land of any moveable structure for the purposes of the permitted use.

The purposes mentioned in paragraph B.2 referred to above are -

- (a) the holding of a market;
- (b) motor car and motorcycle racing including trials of speed, and practising for these activities.



ARTICLE 4(1) DIRECTION TO WHICH ARTICLE 5(4) APPLIES, MADE BY WAVERLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL RELATING TO LAND AT WOOD FARM, PORTSMOUTH ROAD, GODALMING, SURREY

I am directed by the First Secretary of State to refer to your letter of 12 August seeking approval for an Article 4(1) Direction to which Article 5(4) applies. The Direction seeks to withdraw permitted development rights comprised within Class A of Part 2 of Schedule 2, and Class B of Part 4 of Schedule 2 of the Town & Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 in respect of land at Wood Farm, Portsmouth Road, Godalming, Surrey.

- Careful consideration has been given to the information submitted by the Borough Council and the guidance in Appendix D of DOE Circular 9/95. It has been concluded that the Direction is necessary in order to protect the character and openness of the site and avoid the potentially harmful effects of the fragmentation of land in the Metropolitan Green Belt.
- 2. The Secretary of State has decided to approve the Direction and a copy of the Direction is returned endorsed with his approval. The Council is requested to notify the owners and occupiers of land on which this Direction was served of the Secretary of State's approval of the Direction and the effect of that approval.
