



## Who to go to for filming permission in the Surrey area

- Generally anything being filmed on the highways or paths anywhere within the county will need permission from Surrey County Council.

- Shops, supermarkets, pubs, shopping centres are mostly privately owned and permission will need to be obtained from the private owner and not the council. If you are having difficulty finding out who the owner of a property is, other than phoning or calling in and asking, there is a government website where you can find this information but there is a fee of £2.50+VAT.

- Public parks such as Farnham Park, Gostrey Meadow, Frensham Great Ponds and the Phillips Memorial Park are owned by Waverley Borough Council; permission needs to be obtained from Waverley Borough Council, the link below will take you to their website where an online application form can be found.

Applications need to be submitted two weeks before filming and need to be accompanied by a copy of the University's Public Liability insurance and a Risk Assessment.
